Dear Parents/Carers

Thank you for your support during what has been a brilliant term at Blessed Robert Sutton.

Our Year 7 cohort settled very quickly into the routines of Secondary school life and are working very effectively. Pupils in other year groups have similarly responded to the challenge to work hard and 'love their neighbour.'

I know that the children will have their own highlights of the term.
