Curriculum Planning – 6th Form Consultation

Dear Parent / carer,

As we enter 2019 the school begins the process of planning the curriculum for September 2019.

This includes; how many pupils and which subjects, will be taught at Blessed Robert Sutton, the number of lessons for each subject and the teaching resources required to deliver the curriculum.

Three key elements in this planning are;

- the number of pupils joining the school in Year 7,
- the Key Stage 4 Options that the Year 9 pupils will choose
- the Post 16 curriculum, (6th Form.)

It is the third item, 'the Post 16 curriculum' that I would like to focus on in this letter.

All contributions, from you, will be considered by the Governor's and Trustees of the school. The decisions that they make will be sent by letter to all parents / carers on Friday 15th February.

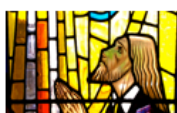
