Waterproof raincoats (not fashion jackets, sports tops or ‘hoodies’) to be worn over blazers, but not indoors.

- Note that jumper does not replace blazer
- No trainers to be worn around the school
- The school has a no jewellery policy
- Girls and boys may wear a small stud in each ear and a light chain crucifix is allowed
- The wearing of heavy or obvious make-up is **not** allowed
- T-shirts and vests with logos are not to be visible under shirts and blouses

Parents are expected to support the school by only allowing piercings in line with school policy and not allow students to brightly colour their hair.

Uniform Guidelines		
Footwear	✓	Footwear must be flat, black, and be of a polishable material. Trainers which are black and polishable are not in keeping with our formal clothing standards.
	✗	High heels/ Other colours/ logos/ trainers including Vans or Converse which are black and polishable are not in keeping with our formal clothing standards.
Blazer	✓	Black Blazer with school logo. To be worn to and from all lessons.
Shirts	✓	Plain white shirt or blouse must be worn with a school tie knotted to the neck.
	✗	Polo shirts. T-shirts and vests with logos are not to be visible under shirts.
Jumpers	✓	Black v-neck jumper with school logo.
	✗	Black cardigan, jumper or sweatshirt without school logo. Hoodie worn under the blazer.
Trousers / Skirts	✓	Plain black tailored straight style trousers (loose fit) or plain black knee length skirt.
	✗	Tight short skirts, lycra skirts, skater skirts, skinny fit trousers, hipsters, or denim of any colour.
Jewellery	✓	Single stud earrings are permitted for all students.
	✗	No other piercings.
	✗	No rings, pendants or necklaces.
Outdoor Wear	✗	No items of outdoor clothing to be worn during lessons.
Belts	✓	Plain black (without studs) and not to be worn for decoration.
Hats/Caps	✗	These should not be worn in the school building at any time.
Make-up	✗	Inappropriate or excessive make-up should not be worn.
School Bags	✓	These should be of a suitable size to accommodate A4 sized books, folders and other equipment, e.g. rucksack, satchel, messenger bag
	✗	Handbags are not appropriate for a school bag.

<p>Strong plain black shoes of sensible design. Velcro fastening shoes or shoes with plain black laces.</p>	<p>Boots. Shoes with heels, other colours/ashes appearing on the design, logos, trainers or fashion shoes (ie canvas shoes).</p>
<p>Boys Footwear:</p> 	
<p>Strong plain black shoes of sensible design. Velcro fastening shoes or shoes with plain black laces.</p>	<p>Boots. Shoes of other colours/ashes appearing on the design, logos, trainers or fashion shoes.</p>
<p>Blazer:</p> 	
<p>Black Blazer with school logo. To be worn at all times.</p>	<p>Black Blazer without school logo.</p>
<p>Shirts:</p> 	
<p>Plain white blouse or shirt which buttons to the neck and must be worn with a school tie which must be knotted to the neck.</p>	<p>Fitted blouses or plain white polo shirts. T-shirts and vests with logos not to be visible under shirts.</p>

<p>Plain black tailored straight style Trousers.</p>	<p>Fashion, slouch trousers.</p>
